Conditions of Entry

1. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
2. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
3. No refunds after closing date except with vet or medical certificate and an administrative fee of \$10 will be deducted. Please note that no refunds will be paid for scratching's on the day of the event irrespective of a vet or medical certificate.
4. PCV club member cards must be inspected at the Event office prior to riding. **PCV Insurance Policy specifically states anyone not following PCV Rules may be left uninsured.**
5. All Open competitors must sign the top section of the "Liability Declaration Form" and fill out the bottom section of the form and pay the additional \$10 **unless** you are a financial member of HRCV, EV/EA, ASHA, SHCA, AERA, an interstate PC or have Liability Cover of at least \$10,000,000.
6. All riders must wear compliant helmets. Spot checks may be conducted through the day. If helmets do not meet regulations, the competitor will be eliminated.
7. Gear Check is required 20 minutes before each phase. Medical armbands must be worn by all competitors and will be inspected at gear check.
8. Bridle and Saddle blanket numbers are to be supplied by all competitors and the number will be allocated and documented within the draw. Cross country bibs will be provided to PCV competitors, however Open riders are to utilise their own back number holder and photocopied numbers will be provided. The body numbers **must** be worn during the Cross Country phase of the event, in other phases can use bridle/saddle blanket numbers.
9. Riders under eight years of age may not compete, horses must be at least age four, no stallions, colts or rigs.
10. Queries, protests, horse abuse, rules as per the PCV *Handbook of By-Laws*.
11. Competitors may ride more than one horse, subject to the conditions of PCV *Handbook of By-laws* multiple horse rules.
12. Dogs, Smoking and Alcohol are prohibited without exception within the Mount Moriac Equestrian Facility during this event. Failure to comply will result in competitor elimination. PCV Alcohol policy applies.
13. This event will comply with the PCV EI and Biosecurity Guidelines, which are current at the time of the event.
14. Neither the organising committee of this competition nor the PCV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
15. Lunging of horses is not permitted at this event as there are no enclosed areas available.
16. Day yards must comply with PCV requirements. The use of electrified tape, strings, ropes or chains, is not permitted at Pony Club Events. Electric tape can be used as a top line or as a "standoff" on a steel or solid yard, but not as a standalone yard.
17. No camping and no cooking allowed.
18. Horse trials cross country maximum heights and maximum spread distance as per PCV HT Rules 2019.
19. HELPERS - If your club (including HRCV) enters 3 or more riders, please nominate one helper to assist on the day, or to support coordination of members of your club to assist.
20. Cross Country (XC) Course Closure – The BVPC cross country course is not open to the public without approval of the BVPC committee. However, it will be closed from **10th March 2019** to Barwon Valley Pony Club members.
