## Equine Influenza

### EQUINE INFLUENZA

Equestrian peak body representatives from Pony Club Association of Victoria, VAS Ltd, Horse Riding Clubs Association of Victoria and Equestrian Federation Australia – Vic, met with Dr Roger Paskin, Principal Veterinary Officer – Epidemiology and Samantha Forrest, Industry Liaison Officer with the DPI on 16 November 2007.

The peak bodies were provided with an update of the current situation in NSW highlighting that things are looking positive in reducing and ultimately eradicating this virus from Australia in the future. Whilst Dr Paskin gave the peak bodies some confidence in returning to activities in the New Year, he informed the group that the Christmas holiday period could prove to be a higher risk, due the large movement of people from interstate to visit families for Christmas or take a vacation. Owners must remain vigilant with people moving on to their properties over this festive season. A gradual return to events during the start of the year was recommended with the size and number of events increasing as the risk continues to recede.

The peak bodies along with the DPI are in the process of reviewing the bio security guidelines for holding equestrian events. The peak bodies envisage there will be some minor changes that will assist event organisers on the bio security side of things. However the contingency planning in the event horses are required to remain at a venue will still be a major hurdle for many organisers. Despite the risk of a shutdown being reduced it is something that organisers can not afford to ignore. DPI anticipates that bio-security measures and contingency plans will be with us well into 2008.

The peak bodies have agreed that is reasonable to facilitate a return of events in the New Year providing the present trends continue and Victoria remains EI free, will provide advice and assistance to organisers/clubs wishing to recommence activities

Agricultural societies may still have difficulties meeting the revised bio security guidelines and be able to cope with either a short term or long term lock down but this is entirely dependent on the capabilities of each individual Show.

The peak bodies will meet again on the 13th December to review preparations for the expected return of activities.

### PCAV Dressage test DVD

The PCAV Educational DVD Library has its first production. A series of DVDs containing all 31 tests from the current PCAV dressage book have been developed. They are designed to help riders, parents and judges improve their understanding of what is required in the dressage ring.

Each test has a voice over which calls the test and gives hints on how to ride each movement correctly. Riders can use these to learn their tests and improve their competency.

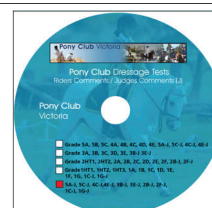
In addition, two tests from each grade have a voice over from a dressage judge who judges each movement and makes comments. These can be used by riders and parents to learn how tests are marked and by prospective judges to practice their skills.

DVDs will be available for purchase from the PCAV office. There will be 5 separate DVDs available

- Grade 1 all tests plus Judge 1C & 1F
- Grade 2 all tests plus Judge 2B & 2F
- Grade 3 all tests plus Judge 3B & 3E
- Grade 4 & Grade 5 plus Judge 4C, 4E & Judge 5A & 5C
- Judge tests from each Grade

The disks are being made available to each club/zone as a set of 5 disks for \$10 which includes postage. PCAV is offering each club or zone one set at this price. The recommended retail price for the set is \$10 per disk or \$40 for the set so clubs are gaining an enormous discount. Additional copies for riders, officials or parents are available at \$10 per disk/grade.

## COMPETITION TEMPLATES WORDING

Clubs are asked to add the following wording on to their competition templates:

Registered Name of the Horse and / or name as officially entered.....

Address of property from which the horse will be moved to the event.....

Address of property to where the horse will move after the event.....

### Health of Horse(s)

I declare that the horse named above will be in good health, eating normally and not showing signs of respiratory disease during the last 3 days leading up to this event. I give my authorisation for the Event Secretary to call for veterinary inspection of the horse(s) named above and in my care should they be showing signs of a respiratory illness at any time during the course of the event. I agree to pay any veterinary fees incurred as a result of this veterinary examination.

### Horse Event Declaration Waiver

I understand that due to diseases such as equine influenza, the Victorian Department of Primary Industries, or other State or Commonwealth government body, may restrict or prevent the movement of horses, vehicles and personnel for a period of time ("Standstill"). I acknowledge and agree that a Standstill is a risk of competing at this event and I agree to pay all costs or expenses as a result of a Standstill.

### Biosecurity Guidelines

I have read and understand the PCAV Biosecurity Guidelines as read on the website [www.ponyclubvic.org.au](http://www.ponyclubvic.org.au) and I will act in accordance with these guidelines.

### Refund Policy

I understand that the xxxxx Pony Club will refund all entry fees if the event is cancelled prior to xxxxx time (eg 48 hours) before the event. If the event is cancelled within xxxxx time (eg 48 hours) or during the event, the organising committee will refund less the value of already incurred expenses.

## HORSE LOGS FOR RALLIES

For rally attendance, clubs are asked to include on the Members Attendance Register the name of the horse(s) and location where it is kept. It is necessary to collect this information once per rider for rallies and the register should be kept at the pony club should the PCAV or DPI require this information. At future rallies, only new horses would need to be added to the register.

**Clubs should log which riders and HORSES attend each rally.**

## RALLY ATTENDANCE FOR SEPTEMBER TO DECEMBER 2007

### September 2007

If a club is not able to hold a rally due to the Equine Flu, the State Council has declared that DC's may grant ONE ONLY mounted rally attendance for all riders in the club. This exemption applies to the period 26 August to 30 September 2007.

However, this rally attendance cannot be counted or used for grading purposes. A member is require to attend and ride in two rallies to allow the DC sufficient time to effectively grade a combination.

### October 2007

Each member will be granted one mounted rally. This rally cannot be used for grading purposes.

### November and December 2007

If a Pony Club runs an un mounted rally the member will be granted a mounted rally but only if they attend the activity that has been organised. This rally cannot be used for grading purposes.

A rider who requires their C Certificate during this time, to qualify for a State Level Event, must be assessed as competent for the written, horse care and horse handling components of the C Certificate syllabus. The ridden component may be deferred until a normal rally program commences.
